

Post Surgical Treatment

For some patients surgery is the only option to help with pain. While some patients respond well to surgery others do not. If you are a patient who has had back surgery; a spinal fusion, laminectomy, disc replacement, or even Harrington rods, and is experiencing discomfort in most cases chiropractic care can help.

Most post surgical patients can be manually adjusted 3 months post surgery. X-rays are always done to ensure that the hardware is stable before treatment begins.
